HELP PREVENT OAK WILT

## **HOW YOU CAN HELP:**

- Do Not prune oak trees between April & November.
- Do Not bring firewood in from other areas.
- Do check oak trees for signs of Oak Wilt.
- Do report suspected signs to: inspection.canada.ca/oak-wilt

## SIGNS OF OAK WILT:

- Leaves prematurely turn brown / bronze, starting at the edges & moving inwards. (Note the sharp distinct border between healthy green & discolouration.)
- Discoloured leaves appear in clusters, starting at the tips of branches. (Note not as individual leaves throughout the tree.)
- Early & sudden leaf drop, starting at the top of the tree. (Note this can also include green leaves.)
- In declining trees raised cracks or holes will reveal mats of fungus.
  (Note the fungus has a distinct smell similar to juicy fruit gum.)
